To discuss and decide:

Which supplier to employ to carry out the works in order to obtain best value - **Resolved**: That Ian Yates Playgrounds be commissioned to carry out the work to extend the play area

Which supplier to purchase the septic tank from in order to obtain best value – **Resolved**: That FTS is appointed to purchase the septic tank and that it is fitted with a low pressure alarm

Which contractor to use to install the septic tank and associated works in order to obtain best value – **Resolved**: That Peter Rimmer be employed to install the septic tank. The Council accepts that there are a number of unknown facts associated with the installation and the cost might increase.
