RE: 12% Increase in Council Tax

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Fine thanks, I can reply via the Freedom of Information Act.

Halsall Parish Council is required to publish a budget for 2025-26. You can find it

here https://www.halsallparish.gov.uk/uploads/otherdocuments/files/2025%2001%20Jan%20budg et%20print%20for%20meeting.pdf, under Documents > Financial Documents > Finance > 2025 > Proposed Budget.

This is a line by budget line analysis from 2023-24; plus predicted outturn for 2024-25 (the 2025-26 budget has to calculated in December 2024; plus the proposed 2025-26 budget.

To summarise, the Precept, the amount that Halsall Parish Council asks the residents of Halsall to contribute was;

2023-24 £32,783

2024-25 £29,436

2025-26 £32,492 which is approximately £35.41 per annum for the average Band D property in Halsall (approximately 1000 properties in Halsall). We calculated that would be approximately a 10% increase, but WLBC who collect the amount take into account that not all properties will pay their full amount due to Council Tax concessions so the actual % will vary slightly from our calculation.

So, the increase for 2025-26 is \pm 3056 for whole of Halsall, about \pm 3 more per household for the year. 6p extra per week.

The largest component of the £3056 increase is a £2000 reduction of income , we can only spend a surplus once and then £550 increase in Employers National Insurance contributions due to HM Government changing NI thresholds and % contributions.

This 2025-2026 year is £300 cheaper than 2023-24.

Halsall Parish Council do not provide Street Lighting or Road Maintenance. I believe those services are provided by Lancashire County Council so would be included in that part of your Council Tax that is paid to them.
