HGV Traffic using the Moss Roads

Please note that following complaints and enquiries from members of the public about increased volumes of heavy goods vehicles using the moss roads the Parish Council in conjunction with your local Borough and County Councillor are investigating the problem and will be trying to ensure that restrictions are placed upon the movement of HGVs to force them to use main roads.





School Roll

At present we have 153 children on-roll and there are 5 classes.

We have 6 teachers and 10 teaching assistants who provide effective support in both the classroom and through special individual/group intervention work. There are about 30 children registered with the Learning Tree Nursery and Smiley Faces Playgroup.

Annual Summary Report

We have recently received our LEA Annual Summary Report devised by the external advisor and it makes excellent reading.

The report asserts that the leadership and management of the school are strong and that the school's self-evaluation is honest, thorough and accurate. It states that the school has clear targets for development and that governors know the school well. It judges that the pupils' personal development and well -being are outstanding, that the quality of teaching is consistently good with much outstanding and that the impact of this on achievement, from on-entry to year 6, is at least good.

December at-a-glance

The garden is magical in winter. The colour palette is limited, but the strong shapes & skeletal framework provide its own kind of beauty & don't forget the garden can be a great source of home-grown material for a natural feel to Christmas decorations in & outside the home. Happy Christmas & Happy Gardening.

General garden tasks

Continue winter digging if soil is workable.

Plan & begin any landscaping jobs.

Clear away any debris to prevent harbouring slugs & snails.

Rake up the last of the leaves.

Send off for seed catalogues to browse through on darker rainy days.

Carry out lawn repairs if weather conditions allow.

Move or plant deciduous trees or shrubs if the soil is workable.

Prune ornamental vines.

Cut shoots for indoor decorations.

Organise your Christmas tree.

Sow seeds of hardy plants.

Plant seasonal outdoor tubs & hanging baskets for Christmas.

Plant fruit trees & bushes.

Continue to check stored fruit.

Tidy plants in the greenhouse & continue to water sparingly.

Check any bulbs in store.

Check tubs planted with bulbs for mice disturbance.

Make provisions to prevent pond from freezing over.

Clear up the shed, clean tools, wash pots & trays – spring will be here before you know!

Watch out for

Chilled pot plants – pot plants that have been standing in the open outside shops may have come straight from a warm & sheltered greenhouse. Poinsettias are especially vulnerable.

Prunus `Autumnalis`. Viburnum. Mahonia. Japonica. Cotoneaster. Fatsia. Malus. Photinia. Pyracantha. Skimmia. Clematis `freckles`. Jasmine varieties. Winter flowering pansies.
